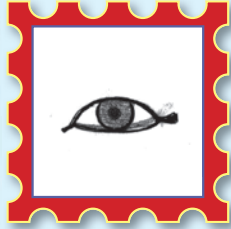


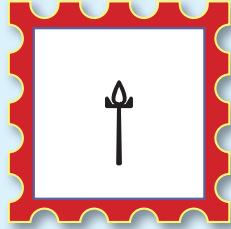

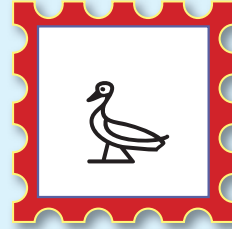
Here are some examples of ancient Egyptian hieroglyphics that represent a word:



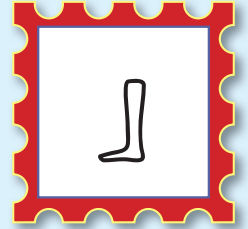

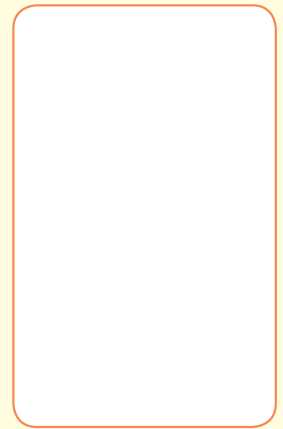

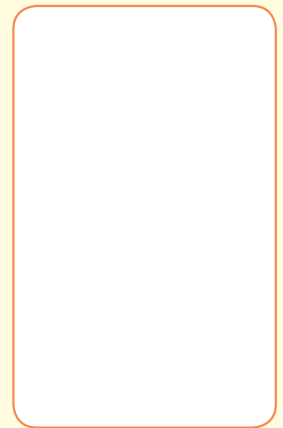
